

BOARD RESOLUTION No. 2022-002
"LED VILLAGE STREET LIGHT PROJECT"

WHEREAS, a long standing concern of the Homeowners is their security within the subdivision considering the low lumens of our existing village CFL street lights previously replaced last 2017.

WHEREAS, last year there have been (2) two reported burglary incidents within the subdivision.

WHEREAS, several homeowners suggested and as one of the several recommendations made by the security agency to secure the village is to replace the low lumens to higher lumens LED street lights to brighten the village streets at night time for better visibility.

WHEREAS, replacing the village street lights have several options;

1. Replace the bulbs only to higher wattage.
2. Modify the existing housing and replace higher wattage bulbs.
3. Replace housing with built-in bulbs.
4. Replace Housing with built in bulbs and replace brackets to increase height of the pole.
5. Replace all including the pole.

WHEREAS, the best option for the village is to replace the whole set (pole, bracket, housing, bulb type), however due to budget constraints at this time, it was determined that the most cost efficient and most effective for this project is to replace just the existing housing and bulb with LED Street Lights Box Type 50 Watts as per recommendation letter written by Director Julian N. Dayrit dated January 27, 2022.


WHEREAS, to change the street lights in the subdivision with higher lumens, it was resolved in a meeting called for the purpose to be funded out of the HOA Funds in the amount of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY EIGHT PESOS (261,968.00), for the purchase of LED Street Lights Box Type 50 Watts, + 10 more extra and 20 LED drivers as constingency.


